

Compulsory Capital Levy	The Compulsory Capital Levy of \$1,230 per child, per year is charged to finance the development, maintenance and ongoing refurbishment of the College's facilities.

NOTES

Fee payment conditions

- Fees and charges are billed each term. These amounts are payable in advance by the end of the first Friday of each term.
- Families experiencing temporary financial difficulties should discuss payment options with the Accounts Office before the due date. If a fee account remains unpaid after the third week of term, and the College has not agreed to a payment arrangement, the school may remove the right of a child/children to attend the College.
- Overdue accounts may incur a monthly administration charge of \$55 if the unpaid balance is above \$500 or \$110 if the unpaid balance is \$1,000 or greater. This charge will be applied until the outstanding balance is paid in full.

Notice of withdrawal

- The Principal must receive a notice of withdrawal one school term in advance of the intended removal of a student. Where such notice is not received, a half-term's fee, including any additional charges accrued (plus GST), will be incurred.

Prepayment of tuition fees

- Tuition fees that are paid one year in advance receive a discount of 2 per cent. Tuition fees for up to three subsequent years, excluding the current year, will be accepted at the full current year's rate (other discounts do not apply). The prepayment fees option is available to families following release of the fee schedule for the student's commencement or next academic year. The due date for prepayment of fees is 15 February 2019.
- The prepayment amount will be applied at the commencement of each term.
- Should your child leave the school early, and provided the required notice is given, prepaid tuition fees are fully refundable.

Sibling discount

The third and subsequent sibling simultaneously attending the College receives a 10 per cent discount of the Tuition Fee and Compulsory Capital Levy.

Voluntary vacation tours

Accounts must be paid in full before participation in a Radford College vacation tour.

CHILD CARE

Approved care

The College's After School Care, Before School Care and Vacation Care program is classified as a 'Child Care Subsidy approved Child Care Service'. Families who meet the Family Assistance Office requirements can receive the Child Care Subsidy.

Sibling discount

The third and subsequent sibling simultaneously attending Outside of School Hours Care receives a 10 per cent discount on fees.

PAYMENT METHODS

The College accepts payment by direct debit, cheque, BPAY or credit card (payments made by Visa and MasterCard will incur a 0.8% fee at the time of payment). The BPAY biller code and reference code are displayed on the fee statements.

Direct debit

- Either 12 monthly instalments or 24 fortnightly instalments transferred electronically from the bank account of the fee payer.
- Completed application forms to be lodged with the Accounts Office by 17 December 2018 for deductions to commence in January 2019 (note that direct debits can still be arranged after this date, however, a catch-up payment may be required). Tuition fees and other charges may be paid by direct debit.

GST

The College applies GST to the cost of all taxable supplies.

Textbooks and Library loans

Students who borrow Library or Bookroom resources are responsible for returning the item on time and in good condition. If items are not returned by the due date, the College will charge a replacement cost and processing fee. If it is subsequently returned in good condition, a refund may be issued on an upcoming fee statement. The charge must be paid before a refund can occur. If an item is lost, damaged, or returned in poor condition, a non-refundable charge will be applied to the fee account.

Insurance

The College is not responsible for loss of or damage to student property. Parents are advised to obtain appropriate insurance cover for student devices and equipment.
