THE FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

Round 1 - Application Form

The Radford College Development Foundation's principal purpose is to support education at Radford College, including supporting students, teachers, staff, parents, alumni and the community. In fulfilling these aims, the Foundation has initiated a student scholarship to be offered to one student in 2022 commencing in Year 11.

The scholarship will be offered to a student who demonstrates outstanding achievement and community involvement, but whose financial circumstances prevent them from attending the College. The selection criteria include a review of recent school reports and NAPLAN results, an evaluation of the applicant's reasons for applying for the scholarship and a determination of whether the student meets the financial hardship test. The recipient will remain anonymous and the successful applicant will be someone who will contribute significantly to the life of the College - both in and outside the classroom.

The Foundation Scholarship covers 100% of the Tuition and Capital Levy fees for two years (Years 11 and 12), as well as up to 100% of other fees.

Application Process

The scholarship process comprises three stages:

Round 1 – application (this stage)

Submission of this form and documents listed below by email to foundation@radford.act.edu.au, or by delivery to Main Reception in the Morison Centre, Radford College, 1 College Street, BRUCE, by 4pm on Friday 12 February 2021.

1. This scholarship application form, including the 200-word Personal Statement
2. School reports for Years 9 and 10
3. NAPLAN reports for Years 7 and 9
4. Passport-sized photo.

Round 2 – next stage (you will be contacted if you advance to this stage)

1. Completion of detailed financial statement
2. Interview of candidate with selection panel.

Round 3 – final stage

1. Verification of financial information
2. Provision of references, which will be verified.

Please save a copy of your application for your own records.

Any decision to award a scholarship is not subject to candidate appeal.

- Scholarship applications are now open
- The Scholarship will be awarded in April 2021
- The Scholarship awardee will be involved in Year 11 Orientation with other year students as well as discussions of subject choices.
