While studying Science at Sydney University, Richard was a keen chorister and an instructor in outdoor education, two interests he has continued to pursue. He graduated with Honours and he spent seven years at Cranbrook School in Sydney. In 1985, Richard joined one-year-old Radford College as a Science teacher.

Throughout his long career at Radford, Richard's energy and commitment have contributed to the academic, co-curricular and pastoral growth and development of the College. Richard has been Head of Science, Director of Studies Information Technology and Communications and Year 12 Co-ordinator. His advocacy for a rigorous Outdoor Education Program was crucial in establishing Year 9 Camp, a seminal Radford experience for more than 4500 students over the past three decades.

Richard's lifelong passion for music has been reflected in his major contribution to the co-curricular music program, particularly in managing a range of Bands and Choirs. In 2012, together with fellow Science teacher Alan Lee, and our dear, lost friend Jonquil Mackey, Richard led the first Science Tour to Europe and the UK, followed by subsequent tours in 2014 and 2016.

We wish Richard health and happiness in his life beyond the classroom, to continue choral singing, cycling and adventurous travel - which will include leading the 2019 Radford Science tour.
