The committee has recently made the difficult decision to cancel this year’s Trivia Night.

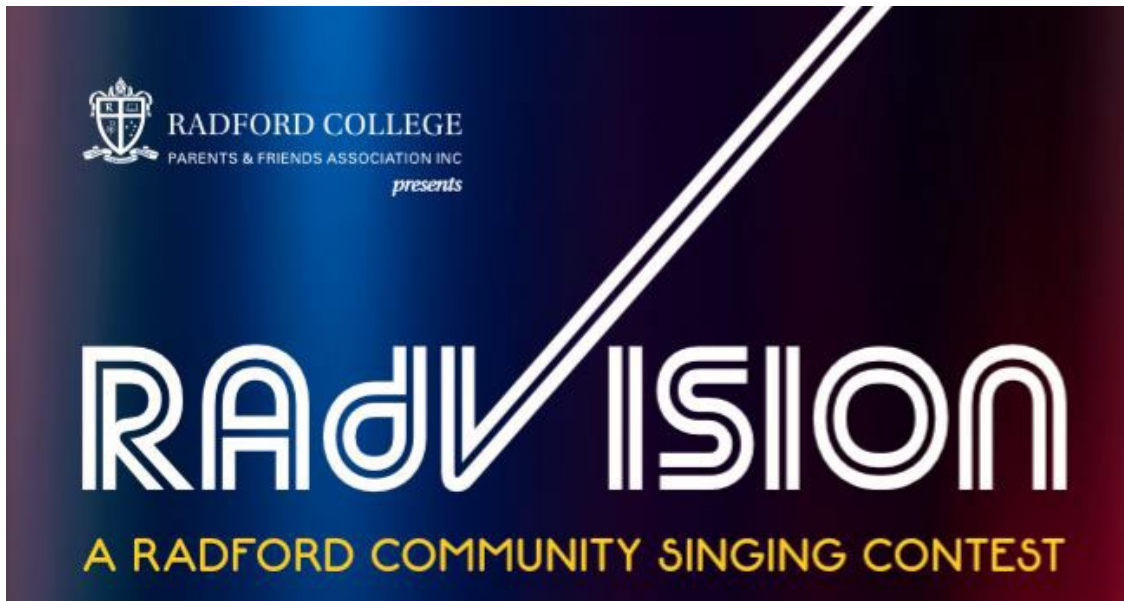
The night is always a wonderful display of community spirit and we are disappointed that we are unable to go ahead with the event this year.

RadVision

The event committee – Emma Holliday, Rachael Harkin, Nicola Gibson and Kate Maguire – has been very busy preparing for **RadVision**, to be held on **Saturday 7 November** in lieu of this year's cancelled Twilight Fete.

Who can enter?

To be eligible, performers must be a student, parent/caregiver, staff member or Radford community member.

The categories are:

- Junior School (students)
- Secondary School (students)
- Community (can include both adults and children)

Entries can be individuals or groups of no more than three (3) people.

Entry and Rules

- Performers must film and submit a video performance of no more than three minutes to the RadVision committee between **Term 3, Week 10 (21 Sept) and Term 4, Week 1 (15 Oct 2020)**.
- Songs may be covers or originals. Backing music or live musical accompaniment is permitted, however vocal performances must be distinguishable.
- Costumes and set dressing are not necessary for Round One, however costumes and performance/stage presence will be a judging consideration in the live Grand Final.
- Contestants must not film themselves performing in bedrooms/bathrooms or anywhere else considered private, for their own protection.
- Each performer or group should have a 'stage name' rather than using their own name.

The Radford Community will vote for their favourite performances between 17 October and midnight on 25 October 2020.

The top four in each category will be invited to perform at the live GRAND FINAL!

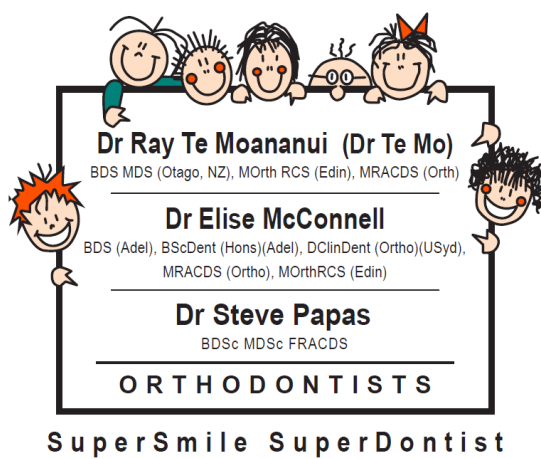
Grand Final

- Finalists will be advised on 27 October 2020 if they have been selected to perform.
- The GRAND FINAL will be held on Saturday 7 November 2020.
- Those who are selected to perform in the GRAND FINAL will perform live in front of the RadVision judges in the TB Millar Hall, with the performances streamed online for the Radford community.
- Due to COVID-19 restrictions, there will be a limited number of tickets available to purchase.
